Directions to Willerby Competition Yard - look for brown direction signs at roundabout & blue WES at Green Lane.

NB Beware when using Sat Nav – you may arrive in Ramada hotel car park!!

From the North - go around York on A64 dual carriageway southern bypass to avoid roundabouts and traffic. Turn off for Hull **A1079** and stay on this road past Pocklington & Market Weighton continue on through the village of Bishop Burton and you will come to a large roundabout –follow signs for A1079(3rd exit/Cottingham) Beverley bypass then take first left and it will bring you up onto A164 to Cottingham. Stay on the A164 past Skidby/Cottingham straight over 1st r'bout and just past 2nd r'bout promptly get into right lane - and turn right into Green Lane. If you miss this turning just go a little further to another r'bout and return. Box park on your left - Drive right up to automated gate & it will open.

From all directions via the M62

Go eastwards toward Hull – the M 62 finishes (J 38) and you continue on A63 dual carriageway – towards Hull/Humber Bridge. Turn off for Humber Bridge and at r'bout take 1st exit for A164 Beverley (Cottingham). Go straight over next 3 r'abouts but shortly after 3rd one(Travel Lodge/restaurants) look for Green Lane turn off on your left. Just into Green Lane you will see the box park entrance on your left - drive right up to automated gate and it will open.

- 5 All competitors must be members of the Western Equestrian Society and must be conversant with the rules of the society. Neither the Society nor the organisers will be held responsible for the failure of any competitor in understanding the rules
- 6 Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times
- 7 No unauthorised person may enter a ring
- 8 Riders choosing to wear a western hat do so at their own risk
- 9 No refunds will be made unless a Vet's certificate or Doctor's note can be supplied

For these to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey instructions given by the organiser and stewards.
