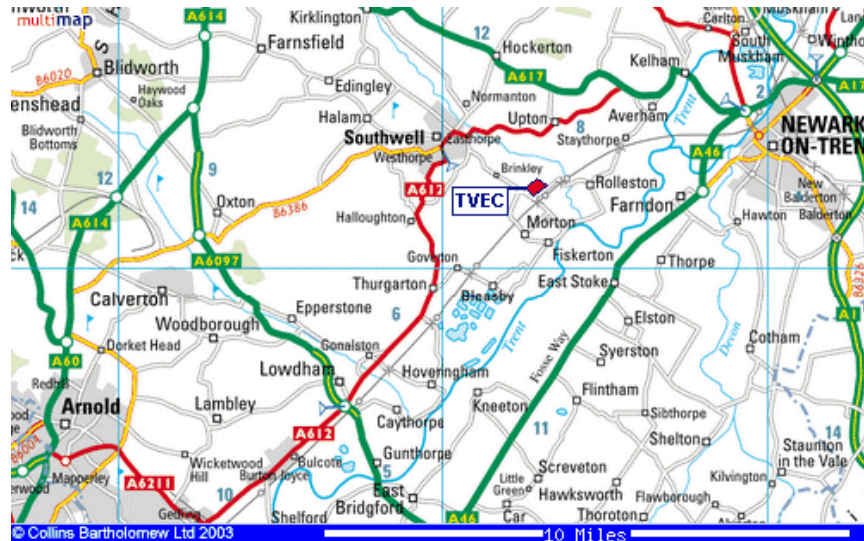
### **Conditions of entry**

1. Neither the Western Equestrian Society, Trent Valley Equestrian Centre, nor the Show Management shall be responsible for any loss, damage, or expense incurred to any person or horse at the show from whatever the cause arising. All entries shall be at the sole risk of the competitor.
2. All objections must be made in writing to the show manager, and must be received on the day of the show, accompanied by a deposit of £10 which will be returned if the objection is sustained.
3. The organisers, at their own discretion, may at any time, before or during the show, reject any entry whether the same has been accepted or not, and their decision in this respect, without giving any reason, shall be final. The organisers shall have the power to eject from the showground any person whose behaviour they consider to be objectionable.
4. No unauthorised person may enter a ring.
5. There will be no return of entries incorrectly submitted.
6. All entrants into WES classes should be conversant with the rules of the Western Equestrian Society. Neither the Society nor the organisers will be held responsible for the failure of any competitor in understanding the rules.
7. Competitors must ensure they have adequate third party insurance cover.
8. Horse riding can be a dangerous sport. Please be responsible.
9. British standards approved hard hats are mandatory for Youth competitors under 14. Youth competitors over 14 may wear Western hats, subject to a disclaimer signed by a guardian being handed to the show secretary prior to their first class. British standards approved hard hats are optional in all classes.
10. Riders choosing to ride with a Western hat, do so at their own risk.
11. Children must be supervised at all times. Parents of children not found to be supervised and causing inconvenience may be asked to leave the showground.
12. Dogs must not be allowed to roam free on the show ground at any time.
