**Novice Youth Classes;** £15 per class or £55 for 4 or more classes in this division.

**Youth Classes;** £15 per class or £55 for 4 or more classes in this division.

**Novice Rider Classes;** £15 per class or £55 for 4 or more classes in this division.

**Amateur Classes;** £15 per class or £55 for 4 or more classes in this division.

**Open Classes;** £15 per class or £55 for 4 or more classes in this division.

**Novice Horse Classes;** £15 per class or £55 for 4 or more classes in this division.

**Intermediate Classes;** £15 per class or £55 for 4 or more classes in this division.

**Championship Classes;** £18 per class or £65 for 4 or more classes in this division.

**Walk Jog Classes;** £15 per class

**Charity Pleasure Class;** £15 per class

Prelim Pleasure Class; £15 per Class

**Little Britches Classes;** FOC, but must be entered prior to the class at show office.

**Closing date for entries is Monday 19th August.**

**For both late entries and new entries on the day there will be an additional administration charge (This applies only to entries that have not pre-entered at least one class).** Late entries are any entries postmarked on or after the closing date.

**Stabling;**

First Night; £35 each extra night £25

Weekend stable £80 (Thursday 10am to Sunday afternoon) . If Sunday night stable required £25 extra night.

**No stable bookings will be taken by the college** and all bookings must be via the Society. Bedding in all stables is Flax. First bedding will be provided in each stable, additional bedding can be purchased from the show office. (No hay available from the collage)

**Stables must be Pre Booked by the closing date.**

Please note that permanent stable is limited and no temporary stables will be provided, so stables will be allocated on a first come basis. Stables will be monitored by the stable manager over the weekend. Please ensure stables are left clean and tidy at the end of the show. Any competitor failing to leave their stable in a fit state will be charged **£25** and may be prevented from attending future shows.

**Travel Subsidy;**

If you are traveling over 200mils (one way) to the show your show will be reduced by £20 per horse. The distance is based on the travel distance from your home address (as given in your WES membership) to Moreton Morrell and based on the mileage given by google maps.

**Awards;**

All class winners, also awards will be given to the High Point winners in all divisions. All winners may purchase a WES engraved buckle, order forms from Show Secretary.

**Walk Jog Classes**

An horse and rider combination that enters a walk jog class cannot enter the corresponding **Championship Class** (i.e. enter Walk Jog Pleasure cannot enter Championship Pleasure etc.) but the horse with a different rider may enter the Championship class.

## Conditions of Entry

1. Neither the Western Equestrian Society, Warwickshire Agricultural College, nor the Show management shall be held responsible for any loss, damage, or expense incurred to any person or horse at the show from whatever the cause arising. All entries shall be at the sole risk of the competitor.
2. All objections must be made in writing to the show manager and must be received up to 1 Hour after that days showing, accompanied by a deposit of £10 which will be returned if the objection is sustained.
3. The organisers, at their own discretion, may at any time, before or during the show, reject any entry whether the same has been accepted or not, and their decision in this respect, without giving any reason, shall be final.
4. No unauthorised person may enter the ring.
5. There shall be no return of entries incorrectly submitted.
6. All entries into WES classes should be conversant with the rules of the Western Equestrian Society. Neither the Society nor the organisers will be held responsible for the failure of any competitor in understanding the rules.
7. Competitors must ensure they have adequate third party insurance cover.
8. Horse riding can be a dangerous sport. Please be responsible.
9. British Standard approved hard hats are mandatory for youth competitors under the age of 14, whenever riding or handling a horse. Youth Competitors over 14 may wear western hats, subject to a **disclaimer signed by a guardian** being handed to the show prior to the first class.
10. Riders choosing to ride with a western hat, do so at their own risk and **must sign a disclaimer** and handed to the show secretary prior to the first class.
11. Children must be supervised at all times. Parents of children found not to be supervised and causing inconvenience may be asked to leave the show ground.
12. **All dogs must be kept on a lead. DOGS MUST NOT BE ALLOWED TO ROAM FREE ON THE COLLAGE GROUNDS AT ANY TIME (college rules).** Please think of others clean up after your dog.
